Sept.19-Nov. 1 - Autumn at the Arboretum

The Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Gardens is located on the shores of White Rock Lake and is 66 acres of beautifully landscaped gardens.

TI employees, contractors and up to five family members have free admission from September 19 - November 1, excluding Family Fun Weekend October 30 and 31. Tiers can also receive a 10% discount on purchases in the gift shop and a special 10% discount on family-level memberships. Parking can be pre-purchased online. You do not need to book tickets in advance – just show your TI badge upon arrival. The employee or contractor who works at TI must be present. If you want to book tickets in advance you can call or email customer service. You will be asked to email the museum verification of employment or retirement.

Oct. 21-24 – TI Days at the Dallas Museum of Art

The Dallas Museum of Art is among the 10 largest art museums in the U.S. and is home to the Eugene and Margaret McDermott Collection of Impressionist and Modern Art.

Tiers and contractors and up to five guests have free admission during TI days, including the opportunity to view the Special Exhibit -- *Van Gogh and the Olive Groves*. You must show your TI badge to gain admittance for your group.
