


TIAA Transition 2019-2022

 - TIAA set up as an independent company.

 - Elected new officers beginning July 2022 & July 2023.



TIAA 2019 Financials – last normal year




TI provided 82% of TIAA funding in 2019

TIAA Education

- TIAA will continue to sponsor educational classes, primarily related to health benefits, Medicare and other relevant health related topics.
- Engaged with Dallas College (formerly Dallas Community Colleges)
 - Dallas College's Emeritus program has courses specifically geared to 55+
 - Access to all 12,000 classes they offer.
 - 6 semester hours free to all Dallas County residents 65 years and older.
 - Opportunities for volunteering/mentoring and teaching classes.
 - Access through TIAA website.
 - Ex Tier, Phil Ritter, sits on the Dallas College Board
- Plans to engage with Collin College to provide similar services to our Collin County resident members
 - Ex-Tier, John Byers, works at Collin College and is involved in their SAIL program.
- Promote curated classes from other sources (e.g. Senior Source).



TIAA Joint Program with the UT Dallas Center for Vital Longevity

The Center for Vital Longevity (CVL) is dedicated to pursuing research that will lead to <u>cognitive health for life.</u> They are composed of seven research labs, each headed by a PhD. With their research knowledge, they hope to prevent, slow or even reverse age-related cognitive decline. The CVL was established as part of UT Dallas by Dr. Denise C. Park, in 2010.

TIAA Member Greg Boydston sits on CVL's advisory committee.


The joint program with the CVL offers several benefits for the membership of the TIAA, including:

- Opportunity to attend frequent seminars on healthy practices for brain health
- Annual updates on research developments with leading experts in the field
- Opportunity to participate in some research studies, where volunteers are needed as for testing/evaluation

To help support the important research work of the CVL, the TIAA is setting a goal of contributing \$200,000 over the next four years (2022-2025), as part of the New Dimensions campaign for UT Dallas. The TIAA contributions will be designated to the Denise C. Park Research Excellence and Innovation Fund, which will be used to support research activities for CVL.Details will be announced later to members on how to participate.
